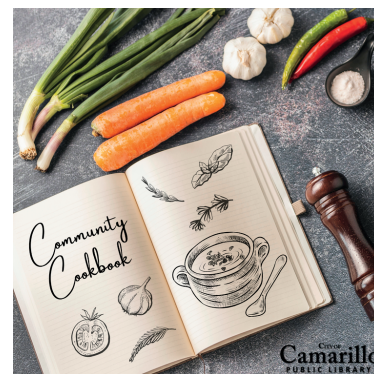

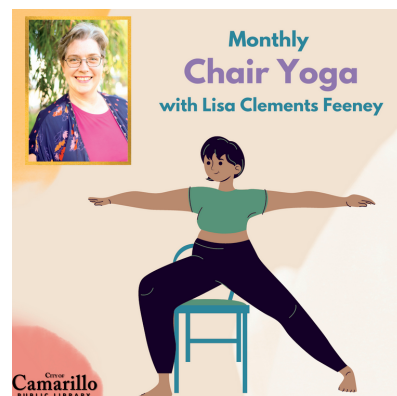


Chair Yoga

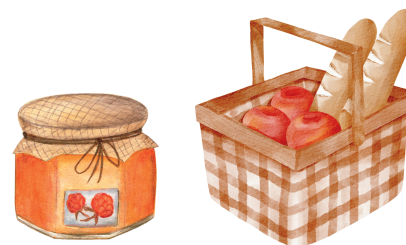
Author Talk: Mallory O'Meara

Every week O'Meara hosts the literary podcast *Reading Glasses* alongside filmmaker and writer Brea Grant.

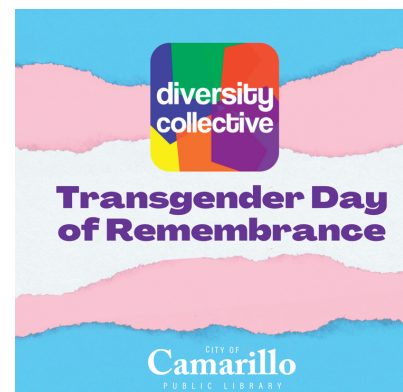

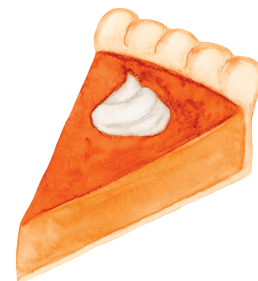

Join Sunshine Storyteller Ina Buckner-Barnette as she makes animal stories from around the world come alive! This is an interactive experience with music.

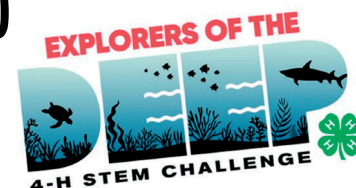

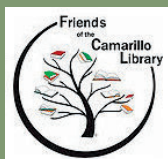
