Saturday, October 7 / 1 p.m. / Community Room

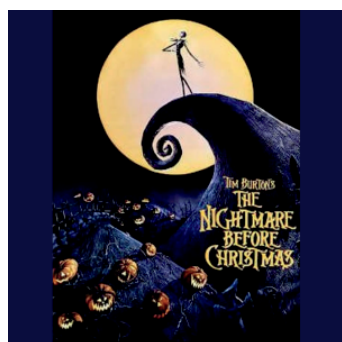

Friday, October 13 / 2 p.m. / Community Room

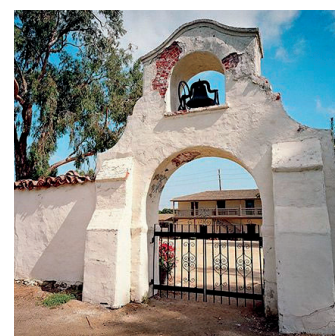

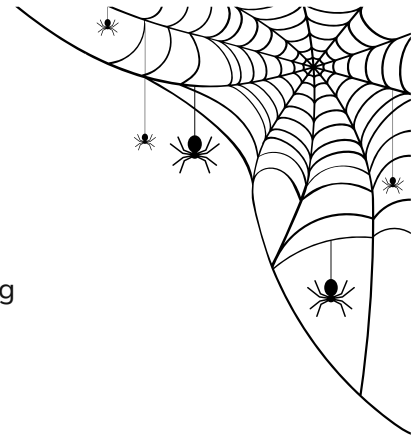




## Felt Pumpkin Craft

**Reminder:** please bring a small photo of your loved one to the event.

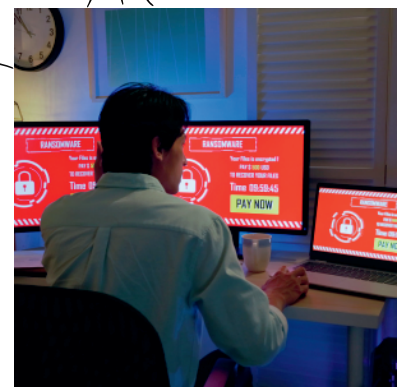

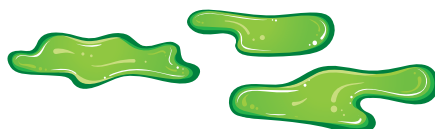
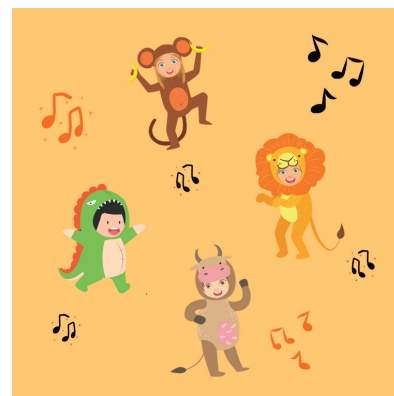




## Halloween Baby Bop Dance Party (Ages 0-5)
