Senior Tech Help

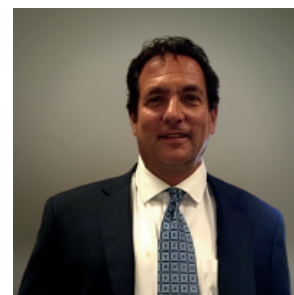

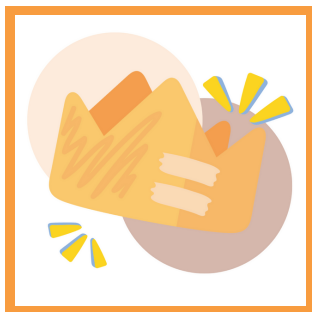
