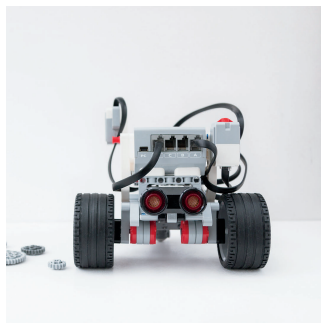


International Games Month: Tournament for Teens
